

**Forensic Work Group Plan, Achievements and Progress
OMHSAS Adult Advisory Update – June 9th, 2011**

1. Mental Health Justice Advisory Committee

- Issued several Grants for program expansion and training
 - Mental Health Procedures Act Training
 - Establish Center of Excellence for PA (CJ/MH)
 - Police Training Assessment for PA
 - Forensic Peer Support Initiative
 - Certification for Incarcerated Individuals to offer Peer Support
 - Advanced Re-entry Initiative for Hard to Place individuals leaving the SCIs
- Established oversight and subcommittees to focus on:
 - Steering Center of Excellence
 - Housing issues
 - Veterans/MH/CJ involvement
- Currently reviewing Strategic Plan and further activities of implementation

2. Center of Excellence

- 14 County MH/CJ Systems Mappings complete
 - 12 more mappings Scheduled for completion through May, 2012
 - Follow up survey to be created to identify impact of systems mappings
- Mental Health Procedures Act Cross Systems Training
 - Developed curriculum
 - 4 “on site” trainings
 - Developing a Web Based version of training

3. Other Implemented Initiatives

- Forensic Housing Issues
 - Committee established to identify barriers and solutions
 - Conference Day schedule to connect with the PHFA November conference
- Re-entry
 - Enhanced Re-entry expanded to Muncy
- Peer Involvement within the CJ/MH
 - Forensic Peer Initiative

- ✓ 27 Trainers trained to facilitate the PS within the CJ system training
- ✓ 3 people trained to facilitate the Training of Trainers Curriculum (ToT)
- Certification of Inc. Individuals to offer Peer Support

 - ✓ Vender chosen to offer CPS training: Recovery Innovations, AZ
 - ✓ Roll out to SCIs Superintendents and MH Staff
