- Recovery Quilt: CRCSP/Centre CSP: Individuals will contribute personal journey squares to Recovery Quilt that will represent collective personal journeys' to wellness. The Quilt will be presented to the community during Candlelight Vigil-MH Awareness in May 2010 and then displayed at various community events/locations.
- Rental Opportunities Fair: CRCSP/Bedford CSP: A community fair to be held in April with local landlords, HUD, PHFA and Community Action representatives present. The goal is to improve relationships among consumers and landlords in local community and clear information about housing opportunities in the local community. This event will assist with the community education about the Community Support Program.
- PTSD Support Group: SECSP/Bucks CSP: Reach Out Foundation will implement a new PTSD Support Group. Thee SECSP Seed Grant will assist in obtaining educational materials and staff/training in relation to PTSD. This seed grant will assist in local community for recovery and wellness and understanding of Community Support Program.
- Montgomery CSP Website: SECSP: Montgomery CSP: Seed grant will provide funding for the development of a website that will list pertinent information about local CSP

committee meetings and activities and links to other community resources.

- Suicide Prevention Billboard: NECSP: Lackawanna CSP: A billboard will contain information about suicide/suicide prevention and suicide hotline number. This project will also involve local high schools with a poster contest for the eventual billboard design. Lackawanna CSP will be noted on billboard as sponsor of project coupled with the CSP educational information presented at the high schools with poster contest.
- Our Friends Place: WRCSP: Mercer CSP: The seed grant supports voter education and registration initiative. And MHA-Allegheny county: Seed grant supports voter education.
